

## ROUND 1 CLUB CHAMPIONSHIPS SUNDAY 13 NOVEMBER 2011

- **What are Club Championships?** Each year Bronte has 2 weekends of nippers devoted to competition to determine the age champion of each age group. Points are awarded for each round of club championships for first 6 places. In the case of a tie the points will be shared between the 2 competitors. The person with the highest point score from 2 rounds of club championships is the club champion.
- **When and where is it?** At Bronte. Round 1 is 13 November (back up date 27 November) Round 2 is Sunday 29 January 2012
- **What time do I need to be there?** U8 to U10s will marshal at 8.15am for 8.30am start so you must be there by 8.15am. All U11 to U 14s should be at the beach by 9.45 for a 10am start. We will start events on time (this will be a FIRST).
- **Who can participate?** Any Bronte Nipper from Under 8 to Under 14s who is registered and completed the junior proficiency swim.
- **Eligible for an award?** To receive an award you must attend 10 Sundays during the season (branch, Waverley shield, State and South Maroubra count towards attendance).
- **Wet weather?** Club champs is generally run in wet weather but cancelled in the event of thunder and lightning. If cancelled we will contact Age Managers and put a note on the website.
- **Surf conditions?** The Youth Director in consultation with water safety will determine if the carnival can be held. There is a back up date of 27 November. If surf is not suitable we will proceed with sand.
