DIPPERS, Bronte, Saturday 4 Feb – 11 March 8am-9am

Our Bronte Dippers program commences this Saturday! Dippers is an inclusive Nippers program, run in conjunction with Autism Swim. Bronte Dippers will run for 8 weeks on Saturday mornings from 8am-9am. We have an incredible bunch of volunteers signed up but will always welcome more. CLUB CHAMPS, Sunday 12 February, U8-U14 from 7am- approximately 10am if full program See timetable here. Set up from 6am.

Sunday nippers is designed to be non-competitive, where kids learn and practice surf lifesaving skills as a group. The exception to this is Club Championships which are normally held on 2 mornings over the season for U8-U14. At Club Championships, the kids compete in a range of races (both in the water and on the sand) using the skills they have learned during Nipper sessions. The child with the most points over both rounds will become that age group's Club Champion at the end of the season. All U8-U14 Nippers are encouraged to compete in these friendly races:

- Sand events for all are: beach sprint and flags.
- Water events are:
 - o U8: wade race
 - o U9 and U10: swim race and board race
 - o U11-U14: swim race, board race and ironperson



Wetsuits are not permitted for Club Champs (except U8 wade).

We need plenty of help to run Club Champs! Please could all qualified officials assume they are needed as finish judges. All parents encouraged to assist with set up.

RAINBOW DAY @ Bronte on Sunday 19 February

In celebration of inclusion, diversity and fun, Rainbow Day returns to Bronte on Sunday morning 19 February! Make everyone welcome at the beach by adding a touch of colour to your beach kit. We will be supplying some bright zinc for any kids and parents to apply. There are similar celebrations taking place at surf clubs along Sydney's beaches and a rainbow paddle-out is scheduled after 10am with our friends from Tamarama (subject to conditions). All patrollers, water safety and U11-U14 nippers (water-safety-pending) are welcome to join.

STATE CHAMPIONSHIPS – Queenscliff and North Steyne – Thursday 23 and Friday 24 February (U9, U10) Friday 24 February - Sunday 26 February (U11-U14)

State Champs is almost upon us! To all our competitors – keep up your training and enthusiasm. Entries are closed for State. Please speak to your age managers with any specific queries. Note that as Carnivals are volunteer-run, the parents of any entered child are **expected to volunteer** at the event - water safety and officials quotas apply to **all** carnivals.

Commitment! registrations have closed. Age managers have formed teams based on your registrations, volunteer quotas are set, time has been sought off school and work, the Club has ordered uniforms and will shortly pay a significant entry fee bill. Nippers are expected to attend all their events and any no-shows will be followed up per policy. Volunteers required: we have a large contingent going to State Champs and need 11 officials and 12 water safety. Please email nippers@brontesurfclub.com.au to volunteer as an official, and watersafety@brontesurfclub.com.au to volunteer as water safety. The draft officials roster has been published. We are very short on our quotas – please sign up ASAP.

All water safety with kids competing who are not officials should expect to be required to volunteer as water safety.

Team meeting: Sunday 19 February, upstairs at 11am. At the meeting, we will distribute uniforms and answer any questions.



Communication at and about State: all communication will be conducted via TeamApp. Make sure you download TeamApp and join the following pages:

- Bronte Nippers TeamApp: join the access group named 'State Team 2023' within our Bronte Nippers
 TeamApp. If you joined last year's group (State Team 2022), nothing required we have rolled it over
 to this year.
- 2023 NSW State Championships: this TeamApp team is managed by SLS NSW

Please also ensure you have the phone numbers of your age managers and fellow parents.

State team post-carnival celebration: Friday 24 February from 5pm. Fish and chips and drinks at the club for our competitors and their families!

GENERAL REMINDERS

The Roll: All nippers must be SIGNED IN AND SIGNED OUT.

BBQ – U7G (11 December - 8am-11am): Let your age managers know if you can assist on the BBQ this week. Help is required between 8am-11am. What a great way to help out our Club – no experience required!! BBQ roster is here.

Pack up: Our Sunday Patrols have asked us to please pack up ALL nippers equipment. Lately, it has been on the beach for hours after Nippers has finished. It is not up to patrollers to bring in boards, flags nor the BBQ tent; once your session is finished, please pitch in to assist. All nipper boards must be packed in the nipper room by 11am. If your kids want to play on a board after Nippers, please look into buying a second hand one and bring it down.

Water Safety: all water safety must sign in via their age group's paper roll each week to accrue hours.
