

Bronte SLSC membership renewal for Season 2025/26 is now open

Membership renewals are now open for Bronte SLSC for all membership categories, and must be completed by **30 June 2025**.

In respect of membership renewals, please note the following:

1. Any members experiencing financial hardship affecting their ability to pay the stated fees, please contact the Club: management@brontesurfclub.com.au
2. Renewals must be completed online via the [SLSA Members Portal](#). *Please note that memberships are not finalised until **BOTH** the membership renewal form and payment have been made.* Further instructions are provided below.
3. *An exclusive renewal period for Bronte Nippers and their siblings will run until Sunday, 21 July 2025, when returning Bronte Nippers are guaranteed a spot. From Monday, 22 July 2025, Nippers opens to all on a first-come, first-served basis.
4. With the impending demolition and rebuild of our clubhouse, we have included an option to make a voluntary tax-deductible donation as part of the renewal process. This can be done by ticking the relevant box on the 'Addon' screen.
5. It can take at least 15 working days to finalise membership renewals. If, after that time, you haven't heard back from us, please email membership@brontesurfclub.com.au

7. Senior Club renewals not submitted and paid before 31 August 2025 will incur a \$20 late fee.

1. Go to your [SLS Members Area Account](#)
2. Enter your username/password (if forgotten, select the link to reset). If you have further technical difficulties, please contact the [SLS IT Helpdesk](#).
3. Click LOG IN
4. At the top of the homepage, you will see your 'Pending Renewals'

5. Select:
 - a. 'Renew membership for a Family Group' if you have a Family Group already set up; or
 - b. 'Renew membership for Bronte' for all other renewals.

To renew individual members of a **Family Group:**

1. Click 'Renew'
2. Select 'View/Edit' under the 'Action' heading
3. Select 'Edit' for each family member you plan to renew and check that their details are up to date
4. Click the browser back button to return to the 'Family Group Details' page
5. Select 'Renew Memberships' under the 'Action' heading
6. Check the season is set to '2025/26' (it should default to this)
7. Select the members you wish to renew and click 'Submit'
8. Select the relevant 'renewal fee' from the drop-down menu for each family member and click 'Next'
9. Select any relevant 'Addon Fees' (including the voluntary building contribution if you wish) and click 'Next'
10. Review the summary to ensure all details are correct
11. Enter your credit card details (Visa or Mastercard)
12. Check the declaration boxes (we suggest you click on the link to the '[declaration](#)' to ensure you understand what you agree to) and click 'Next'.

To renew **individual membership:**

1. Click on the 'Memberships' menu tab and select: 'Update Personal Details'
2. Check that your details are up to date
3. If your details need to be updated, make the necessary changes, tick the declaration box, and click submit. If no changes are needed, continue to the next step.
4. Click on the 'Home' menu tab.
5. Click 'Renew'
6. Check the season is set to '2025/26' (it should default to this) and click 'Submit'
7. Click on 'Select price' and choose the relevant option from the drop-down menu (this should display the appropriate fee for your membership category). Click 'Next'
8. Select any relevant add-on fees (e.g.voluntary building contribution).
9. Review the summary to ensure all details are correct
10. Enter your credit card details (Visa or Mastercard)
11. Check the declaration boxes (we suggest you click on the link to the '[declaration](#)' to ensure you understand what you agree to) and click 'Next'.

Please note that the office must manually approve every membership application/renewal. Given the volume of applications/renewals, finalising your membership can take up to 15 working days.

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A Note for Life Members

There is no fee attached to your membership; we request that you renew your membership following the steps outlined above for individuals. You can also make a voluntary building contribution as part of the process.
