Conditions permitting, we aim to complete ocean proficiency swims this weekend for all U9+ so please arrive on time and ready to go. A reminder that completing the pool proficiency, followed by completing the ocean proficiency, are pre-requisites to participating at Nippers and to all ocean activities for U9+.

GENERAL REMINDERS

- **Communication & information:** the Bronte Nippers Community WhatsApp + the information <u>on</u> <u>our website</u> are your go-to resources for Nippers information. There is loads there!

- **Sunday attendance roll:** All nippers must be SIGNED IN **and SIGNED OUT**. We phone all those who do not sign out, so please be sure you sign out to save our time (& our worry!)
- **No cap, no rashie = no nippers, no exceptions.** Please mark your child's first name in thick black permanent marker on both sides of their cap so they can be easily identified / communicated with.
- **BBQ: U13G** rostered this Sunday. All parents from all age groups welcome to assist at any time. <u>Please let us know here</u> when you will help.
- Water Safety:
 - Reminder to sign in to accrue volunteer hours either via the sign-in sheet included in your age group attendance folder or via the folder outside the Club.
 - <u>final skills maintenance for this season</u>: Saturday 9 November @6.30am-8.30am. If you are not proficient and miss this one, you'll need to request to join a proficiency being run by another Club. See details in <u>sign up form</u>.

 - <u>Help on the BBQ</u>, at minimum on their rostered day, and ideally whenever they can.
 - Assist with set up / pack up (boards, flags, tug-of-war rope, age flag, BBQ equipment etc)
- All General Parents are encouraged to:
 - Earn a 'yellow cap' and help out it's so easy, and a heap of fun!
 - Work towards achieving <u>the Bronze Medallion</u> to provide water safety (orange rashies);
 - o If your child competes, <u>complete the Technical Officials Course</u> to assist at Carnivals.
- Upcoming special events:
 - 10 November: <u>Club Champs</u> for U8+. *Note earlier start times: from 7am for all U9+ and from 9.30am for U8 for the full program. Help needed for set up, pack up, and officiating.
