BONDI TO BRONTE AND JUNIOR OCEAN SWIM, Sunday 1 December at Bondi Beach: **No nippers for any age group on 1 December. U9-U14 encouraged to enter!

The Bondi-to-Bronte and Junior Ocean Swim is Bronte SLSC's major event of the season. It's an incredible day, proudly run by the volunteers of our Club. Please:

- chat with your kids and enter them (U9-U13) in the Junior Ocean Swim at Bondi (see all information here). All Junior Ocean Swim entrants must be registered Nippers (from any SLSC) and pink rashies are compulsory.
- U14 and above can enter the main 2.4km swim (see all information here).
- The B2B is volunteer run and we encourage everyone to support it. Please see here to volunteer.

CHAMPIONSHIP CARNIVALS - BRANCH AND STATE - RSVP'S REQUIRED VIA THIS FORM

Each season there are 2 Championship Carnivals where our top competitors compete against similar from Sydney Branch Clubs, and then NSW Clubs, for Nippers titles. Unlike 'participation' carnivals such as the Waverley Shield and regular <u>local carnivals listed here</u>, these are **only** for our top, committed competitors who are enrolled in regular swimming, board paddling and/ or sand or running training. With limited exceptions, we're looking for a **maximum** of top 8 competitors per group, all of whom should have a LiveHeats band and prior Carnival experience.

- Entries for these carnivals open and close early (during the school holidays) and there are no late entries for either carnival.
- Only those who complete this form (1 per child) will be entered into either Carnival.
- Speak to your Age Managers this weekend if you are unsure.
- As with all carnivals, all families who send a nipper are required to volunteer in some way (water safety, officials, first aid, white shirt age manager, IRB, IRB transport, tent transport, set up and pack up).
- Volunteer quotas are determined based on entries not on who turns up on the day. If your child commits, you commit!

If your child is keen to compete at Branch, please <u>complete this form</u> (1 per child) by Sunday 15 December.

Branch Champs will be held for Nippers and senior competitors at Bate Bay over one weekend. Beach Runs for U11-U14 will be on Friday 7 February (from 5pm) at Cronulla. Remaining events for nippers will be on Sunday 9 February at Cronulla (U9, U10) and at Wanda (U11-U14).

- Remember that this is a championship (not a participation) Carnival so **only strong competitors** who are enrolled in regular training should enter. Nippers should have some Carnival experience and a LiveHeats band.
- Qualifying events for State Champs for U11+ will be held at Branch Champs. These include iron, board rescue and all age relays.
- There is a new requirement that Iron competitors must have competed at 3 Carnivals this season. We are in discussions with Branch re this stay tuned.

NSW NIPPER STATE CHAMPIONSHIPS (U9-U14), 6-9 March 2025 @Queenscliff. RSVPs required by 15 Dec If your child is keen to compete at State, please <u>complete this form</u> by Sunday 15 December (note this is the same form as the above - 1 form per child).

State champs (U9-U14) will be held at Queenscliff SLSC from 6-9 March 2025:

- EVERY SINGLE detail will be posted to this page (the Club gets all its information from this page and is not sent anything additional (the relevant Championships is the 'Age Championship').
- LiveHeats will be used. Competitors must have a band (replacement bands can be purchased).
- The timetable has not yet been published but, in particular for U9 and U10, be mindful of the need to take time of school and work. The timetable will be published to this page.
- Please read Bronte's competition policy for Nipper Carnivals.
- There are **no late entries** to State Champs.
- Remember that this is a championship (not a participation) Carnival so only strong competitors
 who are enrolled in regular swimming, board paddling and/or sand / running training should
 enter. Competitors should have prior Carnival experience and a LiveHeats band. For most events
 there are no pre-qualifications required (excepting some U11+ events, which are determined at the
 Sydney Branch Carnival).
- During the Carnival, SLS NSW communicates via Stack TeamApp: download Stack TeamApp, search for "2025 NSW State Championships' and click 'Become a member of this Stack Team App'.
- Sign up links for parent volunteer purposes will follow.
