

Beach Parking Permit Policy

Waverley Council offers active patrollers who do not qualify for a Resident Beach Parking Permit the opportunity to purchase a Beach Parking Permit for their vehicle. This service by Waverley Council is in recognition of the valuable work our members do in helping to keep the public safe.

The purchase of this permit allows Active Patrolling Members to park free of charge in Bronte Beach car park (The Cutting) without time restrictions whilst on patrol. The application form is available to download (below) and must be signed off by the Surf Club General Manager, or an Office Administrator.

Waverley Council monitors surf club compliance and members must meet the following criteria in order for Bronte Surf Club to approve the parking permit:

- 1. Be a financial member for the current season
- 2. Be Bronze Medallion Proficient for the current season
- 3. Have accrued a minimum of 25 patrol (or combined Patrol / Water Safety) hours in the previous season*

Minimum patrol hours for members who have obtained their Bronze Medallion in the preceding season are as follows:

October Bronze course: 15 patrol hours
February Bronze Course: 4 patrol hours

*Members who have not accrued the minimum patrol hours in the previous season will not have their application approved.
