- **BYO everything!** (LiveHeats band, competition cap, event pink rashie, goggles, board, permanent marker). **The Club will not be taking a trailer to the Carnival.** Please ensure you have everything prior to the weekend, and remember the Bronte office is closed on Saturdays.
- If you don't have a LiveHeats band or have misplaced yours, please ensure you purchase a new or replacement band from 'Central Control' (see map) at Elouera on 8 Feb. This must be done early.
- each Branch competitor should have collected the event pink rashie which they must wear to compete. Some of them are still awaiting collection. If you do not have one, please check with your Age Manager/Team to see if someone has collected yours, or head Central Control at the Carnival.
- Tents: thank you to our parents who have collected a tent. Please help with getting them in and out of cars, setting them up and sandbagging them.

- Check your events via LiveHeats (organisation: SLSNSW Sydney; [Water events are here](#). [Beach events are here](#)). Team member substitutions can be changed in LiveHeats by Team Managers as long as substituted Nippers are already entered into the Carnival and marshalling has not commenced.
 - Team Managers: Jason Gavin, Amy & Zac Sharma, Al Visch.
 - Please write your child's age group + their team name in permanent marker on their arm. EG: U9 Board Team A / Surf Team B.
 - Build in plenty of time to park, find the Club tent/s & fellow team members, warm up etc. Remember that the Carnival timetable is always affected by conditions. Revise event rules [here](#).
 - **Volunteer roles:** Please check the entry lists, together with the role that your family has committed to for the Carnival at the end of the newsletter. Officials, Water Safety and IRB: please be sure to sign-in and attend your briefings on time, in gear, and ready to rumble!
 - If you are listed as a 'back up', please bring your gear (water safety / official). Not all names were allocated by Branch, but as our competitors will be stood down from competing if we don't fulfil our requirements, 'back ups' need to be at-the-ready.
 - If there is no role listed against your name, please remember that your child can only compete because of the generosity of other parents. Treat the children of those volunteers as your own: please make sure that they are fed, watered, chaperoned to the toilet, sunscreened, and kept within your sight. If this is your first Branch Carnival, be sure to get qualified as an official in time for the next!
 - All Iron 'handlers' must be Club members and wear both a hi vis top and a Club competition cap.
