MISSING NIPPER DRILL this Sunday, 10am session (U8, U12, U13)

Each year we are required to run a 'missing nipper' training session and drill to ensure we are as prepared



as we can be for any real life scenario. This is undertaken by the water safety team and overseen by Sydney Branch. When the alarm sounds, all nippers will be evacuated to the park (as per a real life situation), and the roll will be called for each group. Please ensure that your child stays with their group, goes into the park and is accounted for by their Age Managers! Please do not leave the beach before this occurs.
