### **GENERAL REMINDERS**

The Roll: All nippers must be SIGNED IN AND SIGNED OUT.

BBQ – U11B this week (8am-11am): This year, each Nipper group will be rostered on to assist with the BBQ for a full morning (8am-11am). But most groups will be rostered only once in the season. What a great way to help out our Club – no experience required!! BBQ roster is here.

Missing anchor – reward! one of the anchors for the turning buoys used at Club Champs is missing in the seagrass on the reef at Bronte. Hot chips reward for the person who spots it and leads us to retrieve it!

**Get qualified!** A reminder that it is an SLS requirement that **all parents who assist at Nippers with their child** must be 'qualified' (requirements: membership of the Club (insurance), WWCC, plus Age Manager Award to become a yellow-capped Age Assistant or Bronze Medallion to be Water Safety).

Please get onto this ASAP – we need your help, especially with our younger Nippers and we expect your kids would like you to remain with them on the sand and in the water! **Water Safety:** all water safety must sign in via their age group's paper roll each week to accrue hours. Skills maintenance opportunities are running out – please ensure you enrol ASAP <u>here</u>.

**Swimming lessons:** swimming is the foundation of nippers. We do not teach your children to swim at Nippers and swimming at Bronte is challenging. It is not safe, nor fair, to expect your children to swim confidently in the ocean if they are not doing regular swimming lessons or squads each week, all year round.

**No cap, no rashie = no nippers:** All nippers *must* wear their age cap for the duration of their session every Sunday morning and remove it as they sign out. Please mark your child's first name in thick, black permanent marker on both sides of their cap so that they can be easily identified and communicated with. All Nippers aged U8 and up must also wear their pink rashie.

**Pack up:** Please assist with packing up your age group once it finishes and bringing the equipment back up to the Clubhouse, washing it down and putting it away (including boards, tug-of-war rope, beach flags, your age flag etc).

# BONDI TO BRONTE AND JUNIOR OCEAN SWIM, next Sunday 4 December: \*\*No nippers on 4 December. U9-U14 encourated to enter!

The Bondi-to-Bronte and Junior Ocean Swim is Bronte SLSC's major event of the season. It's an incredible day, proudly run by the volunteers of our Club. Note that there will be no normal nippers for any age group on Sunday 4 December. Please:

- chat with your kids and enter them (U9-U13) in the Junior Ocean Swim at Bronte (see all information here). All Junior Ocean Swim entrants must be registered Nippers (from any SLSC) and pink rashies are compulsory.
- U14 and above can enter the main swim or the 1km (see all information here).



• The B2B is volunteer run and we encourage everyone to support it. We still **need water safety**, first aiders and BBQ'ers. Please see here to volunteer.

NSW NIPPER STATE CHAMPIONSHIPS (U9-U14), 23-26 February 2023. RSVPs required NOW for uniform We need to know your child's intentions NOW for State Champs! Please fill out this survey by Thursday 1 December. It may feel early, but the State Champs uniform order is due next week, and entries will open (& close) shortly after.

State champs (U9-U14) will be held at Queenscliff SLSC from 23-26 February:

- EVERY SINGLE detail will be posted to this page (the Club gets all it's information from this page and is not sent anything additional (the relevant Championships is the 'Age Championship').
- The <u>draft timetable is here</u>: be mindful of the need to take time off school and work.
- Please read <u>Bronte's competition policy</u> for Nipper Carnivals.
- There are no late entries to State Champs.
- Remember that this is a championship (not a participation) Carnival so only strong competitors who are enrolled in regular training should enter. For most events there are no pre-qualifications required (excepting some U11+ events, which are determined at the Sydney Branch Carnival).
- Speak to your Age Managers this weekend if you are unsure.
- All families who attend are required to volunteer in some way (water safety, officials, IRB, IRB transport, tent transport, set up and pack up).
- Volunteer quotas are determined based on entries not on who turns up on the day. If your child commits, you commit!
